To be eligible for a scholarship, scholarship applicants must fully complete the application form, including supplying all listed attachments, respond to all emails from Amigos staff, attend mandatory meetings, and participate in our June graduation ceremony. Failure to do any of these things may disqualify you for the scholarship or applying for the scholarship the following year. Amigos will send you a confirmation notice by April 15th that we have received your completed application. If you do not hear from Amigos by then, please call our office.

All applicants are highly encouraged to join the mentorship program and should attend all 5 mentor meet ups. You are expected to stay in contact with your mentor at least once a month to receive valuable guidance to help navigate successfully through the college experience. Our mutual goal is graduation from college with your desired degree.
